4. Conclusions

The dynamics of youth unemployment in Bulgaria follows the general European trends. At the same time economic activity of young Bulgarians is traditionally lower, and their inclusion in the labor market - more difficult due to a number of factors the local environment. Among them are structural problems in the labor market, unreformed educational system anachronistic labor laws and some cultural peculiarities. Data on educational characteristics of unemployed youths in Bulgaria concluded that the bulk of efforts should focus on keeping young people in the education system and training of persons with primary or lower education. At the same time, increasing according to agency employment share of unemployed graduates need faster pace of restructuring programs at state universities. However, in view of their competitive advantages compared to young people with low education and the fact that the state has done or continues to invest in a large number of young graduates in the form of subsidies for training, the focus should be directed to young people with less education.

Young graduates are the key players in youth employment programs at the state and local administrations. The latter, however, have proven less effective and should be limited at the expense of the development of partnership between the private sector and educational institutions.
